Resolution	The proposed Interlocal Agreement with Salt Lake County for the cost share for engineering consultant services requires \$3,750 from the Public Utilities Department budget. The City's financial obligations have been budgeted for by the City Council.	This resolution authorizes the Mayor to approve the interlocal agreement on behalf of the City.	The Interlocal Agreement specifies that the City will pay \$3,750 and the County will pay \$3,750. The County will administer the consultant's contract.

The City Council will consider this item in the New Business section of the July 16, 2002 Council meeting. This item is a routine matter that allows the Mayor to approve an interlocal agreement on behalf of the City. The following are possible motions that the Council can make regarding this resolution.

1. ["I move that the Council"] **Adopt a resolution authorizing the approval of an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Salt Lake City Corporation and Salt Lake County.**
2. ["I move that the Council"] **Not adopt a resolution authorizing the approval of an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Salt Lake City Corporation and Salt Lake County.**

### MATTERS AT ISSUE

The Administration is recommending that the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to approve an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Salt Lake City and Salt Lake County. The agreement is for engineering consultant services to prepare an operation and maintenance easement for sections of the Northwest Oil Drain and City Drain. The City has budgeted \$3,750 for this project. The budgeted amount is appropriated in the current fiscal year budget. The City's amount is equal to the contribution from Salt Lake County. The County will administer the contract with the consultant.

Specific projects details are included in the transmittal from the Administration.
