SUBJECT: Interlocal Cooperative Agreement - Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) I-15/Gateway Streets

KEY ELEMENTS:

The Administration is recommending that the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to approve an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Salt Lake City and the Utah Department of Transportation. The agreement is for the resolution of defective work on city streets that received modifications and reconstruction due to the I-15 reconstruction project.

The City will receive \$125,000 from UDOT for the necessary work to repair certain specified defective work. Once the interlocal agreement is completed and the funds are received, the Administration will prepare a budget appropriation request for consideration by the City Council during a future budget opening. The work necessary to repair the defective items will be accomplished by contracting for the repairs.

As noted on the cooperative agreement, the Utah Department of Transportation has approved \$125,000 for this project. The acceptance of this lump sum payment and the repair of the defective items are the final steps necessary to finish the City's portion of the I-15 reconstruction project. UDOT will be relieved of any responsibility or liability relating to these streets.

Specific projects details are included in the transmittal from the Administration.
