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### KEY ELEMENTS:

The Administration is recommending that the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the Mayor to approve an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between Salt Lake City and the Utah Department of Transportation. The agreement is for the roadway improvement construction project on 2100 South from 900 West to Redwood Road, including rebuilding the Jordan River Bridge. The design portion of this project was approved by the City Council in November 2002.

The City Council does not need to consider a budget appropriation with this resolution. The City has budgeted \$765,960 for this project in the fiscal years 2000-2001, 2002-2003 and 2003-2004 Capital Improvement Budgets. Federal funds in the amount of \$6,735,230 cover the pre-construction and construction expenses of this project.
