RE: Capital Improvement Program Budget adoption - Fiscal Year 2006

On July 12, the Council tentatively appropriated all of the funds available this year for capital improvements, totaling \$13,912,119 in debt, and \$5,659,623 in art, streets, parks, and transportation projects, for a total allocation of \$19,571,742. This does not include Class "C" road projects, which total \$3.3 million, or impact fee eligible projects, which total \$450,000. The attached spreadsheet provides a detailed list by project of the Council's allocations.

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
ALLOCATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2005-2006.

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2005, the City adopted Ordinance No. 26 of 2005 by which it adopted a final budget, excluding the Library budget, for the City for fiscal year 2005-2006; and WHEREAS, on August 23, 2005, the City adopted an ordinance by which it ratified and readopted a final budget, excluding the budget for the Library fund, for fiscal year 2005-2006; and

WHEREAS, that budget adopted by the City included a budget for the capital improvement program; and

WHEREAS, in addition to the adoption of the City budget, the City Council now wishes to formalize the appropriations for the capital improvement program;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of Salt Lake City, Utah:

SECTION 1. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this ordinance is to adopt the capital improvement allocations for the City for the fiscal year 2005-2006.

SECTION 2. Adoption of Capital Improvement Allocations. The capital improvement allocations for fiscal year 2005-2006, which were included within the 2005-2006 budget, shall be and hereby are adopted according to the specific terms and conditions set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto.

SECTION 3. <u>Public Inspection</u>. The City budget officer is hereby authorized and directed to certify and file copies of these capital improvement program allocations in the office of said budget officer and in the office of the City Recorder, which allocations shall be available for public inspection during regular business hours.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon publication.
