Flag Design Contest

The Salt Lake City Mayor's Office & City Council are sponsoring a design contest for a new city flag. The last flag contest was held more than 40 years ago, and although the winning flag has served us well, Salt Lake City leaders think the time has come to retire the old flag and adopt a new flag.

Entry Guidelines:

1. DESIGNS NEED TO BE SUBMITTED IN AN EPS VECTOR TYPE FORMAT AND SHOULD BE SCALED TO 3' X 5'
2. DESIGNS SHOULD BE SIMPLE, CLEAN & CLEAR
3. DESIGNS SHOULD CONTAIN NO MORE THAN FOUR COLORS
4. EACH DESIGN SUBMITTED MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A WRITTEN DESCRIPTION OF THE MEANING & SYMBOLISM CONTAINED IN THE DESIGN.
5. DESIGNS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED ON A DISK OR CD AND ACCOMPANIED BY AN 8-1/2" X 11" COLOR PRINTED VERSION
6. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY 5 P.M. ON NOVEMBER 30, 2004

A selection committee made up of representatives from the Mayor's Office, City Council and citizens with design experience will review all entries and choose those to submit for final selection by the Mayor and Salt Lake City council. The winner will be announced January 2005.

The winner will receive a framed copy of his or her design signed by the Mayor and the Salt Lake Council, an actual flag using their design courtesy of Colonial Flag and a gift-certificate for \$100.00 to Reuel's Art & Frame.
