DISCUSSION: <u>Utah State Governor's Office Grant:</u> The Planning Division has received a grant in the amount of \$10,000 from the Utah State Governors Office, Quality Growth Commission. These funds, plus an additional \$5,000 which is being requested from the general fund balance, will be used to contract with an outside consulting firm to compile an inventory of data on open lands parcels in the City and provide a written report of the data collected. The data will then be used to develop an open lands preservation priority for consideration for adoption at a future date. This grant requires a match of \$10,000. \$5,000 of this match will be met with in-kind services of planning staff and \$5,000 is being requested from the general fund balance.

State Farm Insurance Award: The Police Department received a \$10,000 award from State Farm Insurance for the purposes of implementing a Safe Neighbors Project within the city. The funds will be used for officer over-time to conduct neighborhood education meetings, assess homes for crime and safety hazards, and provide prevention devices that include security lights, fire extinguishers, and carbon monoxide detectors. \$6,048 will be spent on officer over-time and \$3,952 will be spent on prevention devices.

PUBLIC PROCESS: These awards/grants require no public process other than adoption of resolutions after a Public Hearing pertaining to the budget opening.
