

## **Public Utilities Advisory Committee Appointment – Allen L. Orr**

### **INTRODUCTION:**

Mayor Anderson is recommending that Allen L. Orr, resident of the County be appointment to the Public Utilities Advisory Committee. If elected, Mr. Orr would serve a term extending through January 15, 2007. Mr. Orr will be replacing Jan Striefel who moved into the city and now serves as a city representative (District 6) on the committee.

### **APPLICANT INFORMATION:**

Allen L. Orr resides at 3282 East Danish Circle. Mr. Orr is General Counsel and involved in management at the Alta Ski Lifts Company. Mr. Orr is interested in water policies, issues and believe they are of primary importance for the Salt Lake Valley and the State of Utah. Mayor Cullimore of Cottonwood Heights suggested he apply for this position and Mr. LeRoy Hooton has included a letter of recommendation.

### **CURRENT COMPOSITION OF PUBLIC UTILITIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE:**

Public Utilities Advisory Committee members must be a resident of the state. At least three (3) members must reside outside the corporate limits of the city; however, they must reside within the county and within the service districts supplied by the City Water Department. Terms expire on the applicable 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday in January. Members may not be actively engaged or employed in any commercial activity that sells goods or services directly to the Public Utilities of the City.

Current members are Cullen W. Battle, County Service District Rep.; Kenneth Bullock, District 6; Richard Gaddis, County Service District Rep.; Barbara Ishimatsu, District 1; Leland J. Myers, District 7; Michael Polacek, District 2; Jan Striefel, District 6; and Nancy Young, District 6.

### **PUBLIC UTILITIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE:**

The Public Utilities Advisory Committee recommends capital improvements for water resource development and sewage reclamation requirements. The committee also recommends proposed legislation on water and sewage issues and advises public utilities directors.
