RESOLUTION NO. OF 2005
APPOINTING ELECTION JUDGES FOR
THE 2005 SALT LAKE CITY PRIMARY
AND GENERAL ELECTIONS

WHEREAS, Section 20A-5-602, <u>Utah Code Ann.</u>, 1953, as amended, requires that at least 15 days before the date scheduled for any local election, the municipal legislative body appoint or provide for the appointment of:

- (1) three registered voters from the jurisdiction to serve as election judges for each voting precinct;
- (2) at least one registered voter from the jurisdiction to serve as canvassing judge, if necessary, and
- (3) as many alternate judges as needed to replace appointed judges who are unable to serve; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to comply with said statutory mandate and to appoint election judges as required by law for the 2005 primary and general elections which are scheduled to be held more than 15 days from the present date; and this Council has determined that a canvassing judge is not necessary in this instance;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Salt Lake City, Utah, that those persons whose names, addresses, voting precincts, and telephone numbers are set forth on Exhibit "A" attached hereto are hereby appointed to serve as election judges during the 2005 Salt Lake City municipal primary and general elections.
