This canvass must be approved and certified by the Mayor and City Council acting as the Board of Canvassers. The Board of Canvassers must certify that the statement is correct and subscribe their names to the certification, at which time it will become the OFFICIAL results of the election.

The figures submitted in your packets will change. This is because State Code allows absentee ballots to be counted up to noon of the day of the Canvass. Therefore, if a ballot is postmarked on November 7, 2005, received by 12:00 noon on November 15, 2005, it may be counted. The figures will be changed and presented at the meeting at 7:00 p.m. on November 15, 2005.
