COMMITTEE STRUCTURE:

The eight member City & County Building Conservancy and Use Committee was created to advise the Mayor, in conjunction with the Support Services manager, regarding the use, maintenance, preservation and modification of the City & County Building, its corresponding furnishings and landscape elements. The <u>Salt Lake City</u> <u>Code</u> has specific requirements for members of this committee. It requires the committee to be comprised of a licensed architect; a member of the Utah Heritage Foundation; a member of the Salt Lake Arts Council; a landscape architect; a member of the Utah Historical Society; a licensed engineer; and two at-large representatives.
