SUBJECT: **Interlocal Agreement with Salt Lake County for joint funding of a City Creek Water Diversion Structure at 550 West North Temple**

KEY ELEMENTS:

As part of Public Utilities' capital project along the North Temple storm drain, a water diversion structure will be constructed at approximately 550 West N Temple underneath the viaduct. This will be an upgrade to the Countywide storm drainage and flood control system. Therefore, this Interlocal Agreement establishes that the County will contribute \$200,000 to the cost of the project.

The Department plans on modifying an existing structure for this diversion structure.

OPTIONS:

If the Council agrees to forwarding this item, the Resolution authorizing the Mayor to sign the Interlocal Agreement with the County would be placed tentatively on the Council's Formal Agenda under "Unfinished Business" at the March 13, 2008 Council Meeting.

MATTERS AT ISSUE:

This section of the storm drain system primarily handles City Creek flow along North Temple. This diversion structure would divert the flow to the Jordan River along Folsom Avenue. Approximately \$2 million dollars has already been spent on this project in conjunction with the Railroad realignment.

Since the location of the structure is under the viaduct, there are no anticipated traffic disturbances. The construction is estimated to take 45-days.

There are several reasons outlined in State Code for why an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement must be reviewed and approved by the Governing Body. This item qualifies, because of the budget component for the reimbursement items.


Dear Mayor Becker:
