

Public Utilities Advisory Committee Appointment - Dwight Butler

INTRODUCTION:

Mayor Becker is recommending Dwight Butler be appointed to the Public Utilities Advisory Committee. If appointed, Mr. Butler will be filling a vacancy on the committee and he will serve a term extending through January 16, 2012.

APPLICANT INFORMATION:

CURRENT COMPOSITION OF PUBLIC UTILITIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE:

Public Utilities Advisory Committee members must be a resident of the state. At least three (3) members must reside outside the corporate limits of the city; however, they must reside within the county and within the service districts supplied by the City Water Department. Terms expire on the applicable 3rd Monday in January. Members may not be actively engaged or employed in any commercial activity that sells goods or services directly to the Public Utilities of the City.

PUBLIC UTILITIES ADVISORY COMMITTEE:

The Public Utilities Advisory Committee recommends capital improvements for water resource development and sewage reclamation requirements. The committee also recommends proposed legislation on water and sewage issues and advises public utilities directors.
