CURRENT COMPOSITION OF COMMITTEE:

There is no City residency requirement for committee members. Current members include; Dijana Alickovic, at large; Donald Hartley, Utah Historical Society, District 6; Larry Migliaccio, Engineer; at large; Kenneth Pollard, District 3, Architect; Lisa Thompson, Heritage Foundation, District 3; Mark Vlasic, District 5, Landscape Architect; and Harvey Wright, at large, Site Supervisor.

COMMITTEE STRUCTURE:

The eight member City & County Building Conservancy and Use Committee was created to advise the Mayor, in conjunction with the Support Services manager, regarding the use, maintenance, preservation and modification of the City & County Building, its corresponding furnishings and landscape elements. <u>The Salt Lake City Code</u> has specific requirements for members of this committee. It requires the committee to be comprised of a licensed architect; a member of the Utah Heritage Foundation; a member of the Salt Lake Arts Council; a landscape architect; a member of the Utah Historical Society; a licensed engineer; and two at-large representatives.
