CURRENT COMPOSITION OF BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT:

There are five Board of Adjustment members who serve five-year terms. The Mayor, with the advice and consent of the Council, may appoint three alternate members to the board, who also serve five-year terms. Alternates serve in the absence of a board member; however, no more than two alternates may sit at any meeting of the board. Current board members are: Tom Berggren, District 3; Catherine Dunn, District 4; Michael F. Jones, District 6 and Ed Radford, District 3.

BOARD STRUCTURE:

The Board of Adjustment has the authority to hear and decide appeals relating to decisions made by the zoning administrator; authorize variances from the zoning ordinance; authorize special exceptions to the terms of the zoning ordinance; and make determinations regarding the existence, expansion or modification of non-conforming uses and noncomplying structures pursuant to the procedures and standards set forth in the zoning ordinance.
