#### **GRANT DETAILS:**

- The City requested \$19,235 for repairs and maintenance to 16.41 miles of the Bonneville Shoreline Trail from the Red Butte Creek trailhead north to the Salt Lake County border.
- If the grant is awarded, the City will contract with Cottonwood Canyons Foundation to conduct repairs and maintenance along 12.41 miles of the trail and to coordinate of the involvement of volunteers supplied by the Bonneville Shoreline Trail Committee and the Cottonwood Canyons Foundation to assist with repairs and maintenance to 3.8 miles of access trails.
- Cottonwood Canyons Foundation is committing an in-kind match of \$4,495 through 100 hours of • volunteer labor, a portion of effort of the agency's director, and use of equipment.
- Bonneville Shoreline Trail Committee is committing \$9,755 in in-kind match through 500 hours of volunteer labor.
- The City is committing \$5,000 in cash match through Open Space Capital Improvement Program funds toward the labor for the trail maintenance.
