DISCUSSION:

Issue Origin: Section 20A-4-301, <u>Utah Code Ann.</u>, 1953, as amended, requires the Mayor and the municipal legislative body as the board of municipal canvassers for the municipality to meet to canvass the returns from a municipal primary election, no sooner than three days after the election and no later than seven days after the election.

Analysis: Salt Lake County, as the contracted election officer for Salt Lake City, has submitted the election returns of the Primary Election which includes all votes cast during in-office and early voting days, on Election Day, and all absentee ballots returned by the proper date. The City Recorder's Office has prepared the attached report which constitutes the official canvass.

Recommendation: That the Mayor and City Council convene as the Board of Canvassers at the regularly scheduled City Council meeting on Tuesday, September 22, 2009 for the purpose of adopting a motion accepting the official canvass of the September 15, 2009 Salt Lake City Municipal Primary Election.
