SUBJECT: Housing Advisory and Appeals Board

BOARD STRUCTURE:

The Housing Advisory and Appeals Board seek to improve housing and neighborhood conditions throughout the City by providing recommendations of new procedures and ordinances to the Mayor and City Council. The board also hears and decides appeals regarding deficiencies from housing inspections by interpreting and modifying the impact of specific provisions of the Existing Residential Housing Code. All demolitions and landscape waivers, not in an historic district, must be approved by this board.

The Board is comprised of ten members appointed by the Mayor, with the advice and consent of the Salt Lake City Council, to a four year term. The Mayor and City Council aim to provide a balance of geographical, professional, neighborhood, and community representation when appointing members to the Housing Advisory and Appeals Board.

Council policy states that individuals should be appointed to only two consecutive terms or eight years, whichever is greater.
