Issue Origin:

The Council asked that a change of policy be considered. The existing informal policy was that no new historic districts be designated given the existing staff workload. With the addition of a new preservation planner position, the Council indicated they would consider a new policy. The resolution is attached for consideration.

RESOLUTION NO. _____ OF 2009

A resolution regarding the designation of additional historic districts.

WHEREAS, section 21A.34.020 of the *Salt Lake City Code* provides that the City Council may amend the zoning map to designate historic preservation zoning districts in areas of the City containing historical, architectural or cultural significance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously designated certain areas as historic districts and supports designation of additional areas within the City as historic districts, where doing so will achieve the City's historic preservation goals.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of Salt Lake City:

SECTION 1. That the City Council hereby declares that it supports the designation of additional areas within the City as historic districts in accordance with section 21A.34.020 of the *Salt Lake City Code* in areas of the City where such designation will accomplish the City's historic preservation goals;

SECTION 2. The City Council further declares that designation of additional historic districts shall remain a high priority of the City Council, provided that the City's Planning Division maintains adequate staffing to accomplish the goals and purposes of historic preservation.


